A pass mark of 65% is required for all modules, assessments and examinations. • In some circumstances, students may request an extension or deferral of up to one (1) year of the course duration. • Students must attend all workshops required for the relevant Module. If workshops are not offered in their State within their period of enrolment, students will need travel to attend the required workshops. • The professional experience component must be undertaken in an approved Montessori or other classroom as per Study Guide instructions.
